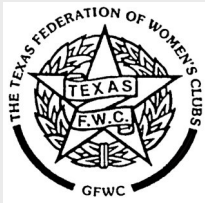

## Meeting Minutes

GFWC WOMAN'S WEDNESDAY CLUB  
GRANBURY, HOOD COUNTY, TEXAS

November 6, 2019

Meeting - 1:00 p.m.

President Cheryl Troxel called the  
meeting to order and welcomed two  
guests who will present the program.  
Pat Flatt brought the invocation.

Peg Harding led the pledges of  
allegiance to the flags of the United  
States and Texas.

President Troxel thanked the  
hostesses: Chair Bobbie Fallin, Doris  
Wisdom, Jonnie Gaffin, Diana  
Boucher, Diane Miles and Zeta  
Martin.

Linda Somervill introduced Mike  
Scott, president and CEO of the  
Granbury Chamber of Commerce. Mr.  
Scott then introduced Shea Hopkins,  
Chamber VP for economic  
development, and they shared  
present actions and future plans for  
our county and city growth,  
employment and education.

Linda Somervill acting in Recording  
Secretary Ann Schmidt's absence  
reported 35 active members, 1  
honorary lifetime and 2 guests  
present. The minutes of the previous  
meeting were filed as presented in  
the October 2019 newsletter.

Cathey Briscoe acting in the absence  
of Treasurer Melinda Charbonnet  
presented both the Treasurer's report  
and the Ways and Means committee  
report. The preliminary estimates of  
the fashion show and luncheon  
fundraiser were a gross of \$39,600,  
and a net of \$28,000. Intake from  
individual events roughly were live  
auction \$10,000, raffle \$1,800, wine  
pull \$1,000, silent auction \$1,500,  
100% table challenge \$6,000 (the  
club's largest contribution on record).  
She noted that the event was very  
successful despite ticket sales and  
sponsorships being down from last  
year. The final report will be  
presented at the December meeting.

Ways and Means Committee  
members presented flowers to the  
committee co-chairs Cathey Briscoe  
and Pat Flatt in appreciation of their  
successful efforts for the fundraiser.

President Troxel announced that Lori  
Kaspar has resigned due to her work  
schedule and the club needs a new  
newsletter chairman.
